<b>General Waste</b>	<b>\$43.05</b> Min: \$19.00	General waste material, such as household trash and furniture. <i>(See back for more information.)</i>
<b>Extra Handling</b>	<b>\$83.75</b> Min: \$64.25 + additional per item charges	Loads requiring additional processing or equipment usage <i>(see back for more info)</i> .
<b>Special Disposal</b>	<b>\$128.85</b> Min: \$77.25	Materials needing to be covered immediately after disposal <i>(see back for more info)</i> .

## SEPARATED MATERIALS FOR THE RESOURCE RECOVERY AREA

MATERIAL	COST PER TON	NOTE: Unseparated materials are charged the waste disposal rates as listed above.
<b>Recyclables</b>	<b>NO CHARGE</b>	Cardboard, paper, bottles, jugs and cans. <i>(See back for more info)</i>
<b>Asphalt</b>	<b>NO CHARGE</b>	Clean, separated asphalt. <i>(See back for more info)</i>
<b>Clean Concrete</b>	<b>NO CHARGE</b>	Less than two feet in any direction. <i>(See back for more info)</i>
<b>Oversized Concrete</b>	<b>\$20.00</b>	More than two feet in any direction and/or protruding rebar. <i>(See back for more info)</i>
<b>Clean Dirt</b>	<b>\$29.00</b> Min: \$19.00	Clean and debris-free dirt. <i>(See back for more info)</i>
<b>Grass and Leaves</b>	<b>\$10.50</b> Min: \$7.00	Loads only including grass and/or leaves. <i>(See back for more info)</i>
<b>Brush and Wood</b>	<b>\$21.00</b> Min: \$10.00	Clean loads of separated brush and/or untreated wood. <i>(See back for more info; brush and wood materials go into different piles)</i>

<b>Mattress or Box Spring</b>	<b>\$5.00</b>		If there are more than 6 mattresses/box springs, please see "Extra Handling" description.

MATERIALS TO BE LANDFILLED	
MATERIAL	DESCRIPTION of MATERIAL TYPES
<b>General Waste</b>	General waste material, such as household trash and furniture. (Appliances, mattresses and tires have additional charges per item. Please see "Additional Charges" below.)
<b>Extra Handling</b>	Loads requiring extra handling include: large sheet plastic, wire of any kind, baling twine, large tree stumps/logs and railroad ties or telephone poles over three feet; bulky items including tanks, long pipes, boat pontoons. Unseparated appliances & over 6 tires per load (plus additional per item charges). Over 6 unseparated mattresses/box springs per load (no additional per item charge). Other as determined by landfill staff.
<b>Special Disposal</b>	Material requiring special disposal as determined by Authority Management. Includes, but not limited to: sensitive records, foodstuffs, autoclaved medical waste and non-friable asbestos. ALL SPECIAL DISPOSALS ARE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY UNLESS PRE-APPROVED BY AUTHORITY MANAGEMENT.

SEPARATED MATERIALS FOR THE RESOURCE RECOVERY AREA	
MATERIAL	NOTE: Contaminated or mixed materials are charged the waste disposal rates as listed above.
<b>Recyclables</b>	Aluminum cans; Cardboard (non-waxed); Glass bottles and jars (rinsed, lids removed); Paper (newspaper, office paper, food boxes); and Plastic (bottles and jugs)
<b>Asphalt</b>	Separated and uncontaminated loads of sand, gravel, road base or asphalt
<b>Clean Concrete</b>	Separated and clean loads of concrete or brick (no more than 2 feet in any direction). No dirt or protruding re-bar.
<b>Oversized Concrete</b>	More than 2 feet in any direction and/or with re-bar protruding more than 6 inches.
<b>Clean Dirt</b>	Dirt must be clean and free of debris and/or contaminants. Dirt that has trash, debris or other contaminants will be charged as General Waste.
<b>Grass and Leaves</b>	Grass and/or leaves only, not containing brush or contaminants.
<b>Brush and Wood</b>	Loads with separated <b>a)</b> brush/prunings or <b>b)</b> pallets/lumber. For brush, materials must not be over 12" in diameter. <b>Note:</b> Oleander, Palm and Yucca are considered "General Waste". Treated Wood is accepted for disposal at the Highway 59 Landfill as "General Waste."

ADDITIONAL CHARGES [Each item listed below carries an additional charge (per item) to regular load charges listed above]	
MATERIAL	DESCRIPTION
<b>Refrigerated APPLIANCES</b>	Any appliance requiring refrigerant gas to operate; such as a refrigerator, cooler or chilled water dispenser.
<b>Non-refrigerated APPLIANCES</b>	Not requiring refrigerant gas to operate; such as a clothes dryer, microwave, dishwasher, etc.
<b>MATTRESS or BOX SPRING</b>	If there are more than 6 mattresses/box springs, please see "Extra Handling" above.
<b>T I R E S</b>	(Must have rims removed for the rates below to apply. <b>Tire w/ rim = \$5 surcharge per rim</b> ) <b>Notice:</b> It is unlawful to transport more than 9 tires without a letter of exemption or a waste tire hauler certificate. Highway Patrol can issue a citation for this. Please call the Merced County Environmental Health Division at 209-381-1100 for information on how to obtain this.
<b>Car or Light Truck Tire</b>	Up to 16.5 inch rim for up to nine (9) tires per load. Ten or more tires will be weighed under the Bulk Tire Rate of \$180/ton.
<b>Truck Tire</b>	(standard sizes) from 16.5 in. to 24.5 in rim
<b>Tractor Tire</b>	14" x 20" to 17.5" x 24.5", with thin sidewall
<b>Loader Tire</b>	17.5" x 22" to 23.5" x 25", less than 15 ply
<b>Earthmover Tire</b>	Over 23.5" x 25", or greater than 19" wide x 50" height with a thick side wall greater than 15 ply
